[12.2.1] Does your university as a body have a policy on ethical sourcing of food and supplies?

NCUT's Policy on Ethical Sourcing of Food and Supplies

NCUT enforces a strict Green Procurement Policy, in line with Taiwan's Ministry of Environment regulations, to ensure the ethical and sustainable sourcing of food, supplies, and services.

Features of the 2025 Policy:

1. Recognition and Achievement

- NCUT achieved a 100-point score in 2024, maintaining its status as an "Excellent School for Green Procurement" for 16 consecutive years (2009–2024).
- The 2025 goal is to sustain this level of excellence, with a benchmark score of 90 points or above set by the Ministry of Environment.

2. Mandatory Use of Eco-Labeled Products

- All units must purchase from the 47 categories of Designated Procurement Items, prioritizing products with environmental, energy-saving, or water-saving labels.
- Products without environmental labels may not be ordered via the Government Electronic Procurement Network.

3. Approval Process for Exceptions

- If non-eco products are required, units must:
 - Document the absence of eco-labeled alternatives using the Net Zero Green Living database.
 - Submit a formal explanation to the Environmental Protection and Safety and Health Center, with approval required from the university president.

4. Green Procurement in Construction

- Contractors must adopt green procurement during project implementation and report results via the Government Green Procurement Reporting Platform.



This policy ensures that NCUT not only prioritizes eco-friendly and ethically sourced products but also integrates environmental accountability into all levels of procurement and construction projects.

5. Green Procurement Policy

- NCUT aligns with Taiwan’s government green procurement policy and established its own Green Procurement Operation Management Points.
- Departments prioritize products with eco-labels, energy-saving, and water-saving certifications.
- From 2009–2022, NCUT maintained a green procurement ratio above 95%, earning recognition from the Ministry of Education in 2014 for its outstanding commitment

6. Procurement from Sheltered Workshops

- NCUT follows the Regulations for Preferential Procurement of Products and Services from Welfare Organizations for the Disabled and Sheltered Workshops.
- In 2023 and 2024, NCUT purchased NT\$1,919,224 worth of goods and services from these organizations, directly supporting disadvantaged communities

7. Ethical Procurement Standards

- NCUT integrates ethical food sourcing principles, ensuring cultivation and processing respect environmental protection, worker welfare, and consumer health.
- This approach fosters transparency and responds to consumer demand for socially and environmentally responsible sourcing

8. Energy-Efficient Equipment and Supplies

- Under NCUT’s Energy Policy, signed by President Chen Wenyan, the university commits to procuring energy-efficient appliances to reduce carbon emissions and support low-carbon campus development

9. Green Store System (External Collaboration)

- NCUT promotes Taiwan’s **Green Store system** (physical and virtual), encouraging eco-labeled product use, green sales strategies, recycling, and consumer education on responsible purchasing

Contribution to SDGs

- **SDG 8 – Decent Work and Economic Growth:** Supporting sheltered workshops and disadvantaged workers.
- **SDG 12 – Responsible Consumption and Production:** Enforcing sustainable and ethical procurement.
- **SDG 13 – Climate Action:** Prioritizing energy-efficient and eco-certified products.
- **SDG 17 – Partnerships for the Goals:** Working with government and retailers to advance green consumerism.

A. Sustainable Public Procurement

(A) Green Procurement

In response to environmentally friendly green energy technology and emphasizing the importance of green procurement, NCUT has formulated the National Chin-Yi University of Technology Green Procurement Operation Management Points to prioritize purchasing energy-saving and water-saving environmentally friendly labeled products. Therefore, in the 15 years from 2009 to 2023, NCUT achieved a green procurement ratio of over 95%, earning recognition as an outstanding school by the Ministry of Education. Statistics are shown in Table 47.

(B) Procurement from Sheltered Workshops

NCUT has implemented the Regulations for the Preferential Procurement of Products and Services Produced by Physical and Mental Disability Welfare Organizations or Charitable Workshops, and adheres to the principles of supporting disadvantaged communities and caring for physically and mentally disabled individuals. NCUT prioritizes physical and mental disability welfare organizations and charitable workshops when awarding bids in priority procurement projects to action this support. In 2022 and 2023, the number of products and services preferentially purchased by NCUT from physical and mental disability welfare organizations and charitable workshops increased year by year, as shown in Table 48.

The **Green Store system**, introduced in April 2008, aims to promote eco-labeled products and foster green consumerism among the general public in Taiwan. Today, there are over 10,000 Green Stores nationwide, with a growing presence in both physical and virtual spaces. By 2013, internet-based retailers could apply to become virtual Green Stores as well, broadening access to eco-friendly products.

Green Stores are categorized into **chain stores** and **community stores**, both of which must fulfill several requirements to promote green products:

Green Store Requirements:

1. **Introduction and management of green products:** Green Stores must offer an array of eco-friendly products, displayed attractively to encourage green consumerism.
2. **Green sales strategy:** Stores are required to integrate eco-friendly concepts into their sales strategies, ensuring that consumers are provided with information on green products and their benefits.
3. **Environmental and public health management:** Green Stores must use environmentally friendly or recyclable materials in packaging and adopt practices that support sustainability.
4. **Advocacy of green consumerism:** Stores should continuously provide consumers with information regarding eco-friendly products and promote the importance of green consumerism.
5. **Participation in eco-friendly activities:** Beyond selling green products, Green Stores are expected to engage in eco-friendly promotional activities.
6. **Recycling resources:** Green Stores are required to set up a recycling area with clear signage and educational information to promote the recycling of materials.

Application Process:

Retailers wishing to apply to become Green Stores must register with the **Ministry of Economic Affairs** and meet several key indicators before applying:

1. **Validation of green products:** Ensure that products meet eco-friendly standards as listed on the Green-living Information Platform, including products with the **Green Mark** or **Carbon Footprint Label**.
2. **Highlight green products:** Use stickers or signs to clearly label eco-friendly products.
3. **Proper labeling:** Confirm that all green products are correctly labeled with eco-certification.
4. **Virtual Green Stores:** For online stores, applicants must create a dedicated section for green products on their website, including catalogs, multimedia information, or post-ordering

 - (3)「無法採購環保(節能、省水)標章產品」理由書，請務必於請購「前」依下列程序辦理：
 - A. 至「淨零綠生活」網站「首頁/綠生活選擇/環保產品查詢」，鍵入關鍵字查詢，確無此產品環保標章證號時，請先按「匯出PDF」後再列印畫面以為佐證。
 - B. 填寫「無法採購環保(節能、省水)標章產品」(如附件2)敘明理由。
 - C. 將本理由書簽會環境保護及安全衛生中心，陳請校長核示，奉核後始得購買(不論採購金額)。
4. 請各單位辦理工程及勞務採購涉及綠色採購項目時，要求承攬廠商於計畫執行過程中，積極實施綠色採購，並由承攬廠商至「民間企業及團體綠色採購申報平臺」申報綠色採購金額。
